# 1. Tournament organizer

# 3. Date and place of the tournament

- The Summer Ice Hockey Tournament U13 will be held at the Torbyd Ice Rink, Toruńska 59, 85-023 Bydgoszcz, Poland.
- The tournament will take place on June 22-23, 2024. The tournament starts at 12:00 (Saturday), and ends at 18:00 (Sunday).

#### 4. Teams

- The tournament is open to teams representing the AAA category level.
- 6 registered select teams will take part in the tournament.
- Select teams have priority to register.
- Registration for the tournament can be done through the website: https://www.superturnaje.cz/
- Registration can also be made by phone or e-mail.
- The tournament organizer reserves the right to refuse to register some teams without giving reasons for refusing their participation.
- The deadline for registering teams for the tournament ends on June 10, 2024.
- The cost of participation of each team in the tournament is 500 Euro, payable in cash on the day of the tournament, during team registration.

- The registration fee does not include accommodations for the teams.
- The organizer provides lunches (for 12 players), drinks and snacks to all tournament players. Each additional lunch costs 8 euros.
- The organizer does not provide insurance for players during the tournament.

# 5. Team line-ups

- The line-ups may include players born in 2012 and younger.
- The line-ups of the teams may consist of: minimum 10 players and 1 goalie, maximum 20 players and 2 goalies.
- The teams' line-ups must be sent to the organizer at the latest two days before the start of the tournament.
- Each player taking part in the tournament must have an ID, which will be checked during team registration before the tournament starts.

#### 6. Scheme of games

- The tournament will be played in a round-robin format.
- At the end of the group stage, the knockout stage will be played.

#### 7. Match rules

- Matches will be played in formations 5x5.
- Each team will play at least 5 matches in the tournament.
- One game time is 2x20 minutes (time stopped during game breaks).
- Body checking is allowed.
- For a victory in a group match a team receives 3 points, for a draw 1 point, and for a loss 0 points.
- Each player must play with full hockey equipment.

# 8. Classification after the group stage

- 1. Points.
- 2. Direct match score.
- 3. Goal difference.
- 4. More goals scored.
- 5. Fewer goals conceded.

#### 9. Awards

- Cups and medals are planned for the teams from the first three places.
- Individual prizes will be awarded to the best players of the tournament.

# 10. Tournament committee

In case of disputes and not included in these rules and regulations, the decision shall be made by the tournament committee, whose composition shall be chosen by the organizer.

#### 11. Safety rules

- The organizer is not responsible for the consequences of accidents.
- A player may be disqualified for unsportsmanlike behaviour that endangers the safety of participants in the tournament.

# 12. General rules

- Failure to comply with the regulations may result in disqualification of the team.
- Participation in the tournament means acceptance of these regulations.
- The organizer reserves the right to amend these Regulations at any time.
