## TOURNAMENT PRACTICALITIES

### GENERAL PROVISIONS

#### Accommodation

*The tournament organizer reserves the right to provide meals and accommodation. It is exclusively serviced by our partner hotels at a discounted rate. Please address all requests with the tournament coordinator no later than February 28.02.2025*

#### Meals

*Lunch orders for players should be sent together with the completed team roster no later than April 14, 2025 to the tournament coordinator. Payment 250,- CZK for lunch at the ice rink, in cash at registration.*

#### Tournament schedule

*A detailed timetable will be supplied in due course once all teams have been confirmed. Teams are required to adhere to the tournament schedule and be ready to play no later than 5 minutes prior to the start of the game as specified in the schedule.*

#### Entry fee

### **Prices**

*Teams placed 1st and 2nd will receive medals and trophies. Individual awards will be given to the best players of the whole tournament, directly after the last match.*

### **Other Information**

*Coaches and team leaders are responsible for maintaining the rules of good conduct and sportsmanship. At the same time, the leaders are responsible for any damage caused by the team in the sports facilities and accommodation provided by the organizer.*

### **Final Provisions**

*Teams are obliged to follow these regulations and the organizer's instructions throughout the tournament. The organizer reserves the right to make corrections or changes to these rules and regulations if need be or having a smooth and peaceful tournament so requires.*

### **Participation requirements**

*Players of age category U14 + 3 players born after 15.9.2010. Girls according to CSLH rules. The condition of participation is the submission of a team roster signed by the manager and coach and valid registration cards for Czech teams, passports or other official documents reliably proving the year of birth of the player for foreign teams. The above mentioned documents must be presented at the registration of the teams before the start of the tournament. Without these documents, the registered team or player will not be allowed to participate in the tournament!!! Each team can nominate a maximum of 22 players per category and 4 accompanying persons, for a total of 26 persons. All players start the tournament at their own risk. In case of hospital treatment, players must have proof of ice hockey insurance (players from EU countries have health insurance cards).*

### **Tournament system**

*Each team will play 4 matches in the group stage + 1- 4 PLAY-OFF matches. The teams in the group play each other. All teams must be ready to start on time for their matches, the organizer reserves the right to delay the start of the match by 10 minutes. The following is decisive for determining the ranking:*

- 1. Higher number of points*
- 2. Result of mutual match between the teams in question.*
- 3. Difference between goals scored and goals received.*
- 4. Greater number of goals scored.*
- 5. In case of equality between three or more teams, a narrower table and in it according to points: 1, 3, 4.*
- 6. Fewer number of penalty minutes*
- 7. Coefficient*
- 8. Draw*





### **Objections**

*Each team may object to the conduct and result of its own match. The objection must be submitted no later than 10 minutes after the end of the match, in writing to the tournament manager with a deposit of 1000,- CZK. If the objection is rejected, the deposit will be forfeited to the tournament organizer, otherwise it will be returned.*

### **Locker rooms**

*Only players and members of the team are allowed to enter the dressing room area. Team managers are responsible for maintaining order in the changing rooms. The tournament organizer is not responsible for valuable items left in the locker rooms. The deposit for the keys to the locker room is 1000,- CZK. The deposit will be refunded after handing over a clean and undamaged locker room.*

### **Medical Service**

*Medical service will be present throughout the tournament and will be provided by the organizer.*



## **TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS**

### **Rules**

- a) *The game shall be played according to the rules of ice hockey, the Competition and Disciplinary Regulations of the CSHL and the provisions of these regulations. The Tournament Director and the Tournament Organizing Committee shall have the final decision in all disputed cases.*
- b) *Teams of the age category U14 and younger will participate in the tournament.*
- c) *Team leaders will fill the roster and send it before the tournament starts (no later than 14. April 2025)*
- d) *The roster may include a maximum of 22 players + 4 members of the management team.*
- e) *The team manager is responsible for ensuring that all participating players are properly insured and have a valid medical examination.*
- f) *Each team must have two sets of jerseys (light - dark) with numbers. The team listed in the tournament schedule as the home team shall play in light colored jerseys.*

### **Game regulations**

- a) *All group and PLAY-OFF matches are played in 3 x 15 minutes.*
- b) *The length of penalties when a player is sent off is as follows: minor penalty = 2 minutes net time, major penalty = 5 minutes net time, personal penalty = 10 minutes net time. If a player is sent off before the end of the match, the tournament management will decide on his participation in the next (next) match.*
- c) *Ice surface adjustment in the groups and PLAY-OFF is always done after the end of the match.*
- d) *Teams will have 2 minutes of warm-up time before each match, the match will start immediately after the warm-up, without any adjustment of the playing surface.*
